BACK TO SCHOOL HEALTH CHECK-UP

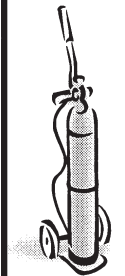
Make Sure Your Kids Are Healthy and Ready to Learn

New books, backpacks, bus schedules...there's a lot for parents and kids to think about as a new school year gets underway. Don't forget that back to school health check up.

The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends a check up each year from ages 2 to 6 and one at 8 and 10 years, and one each year after age 11. An additional examination is often required for participation in a school sport. The Doctor may check your child's height, weight, blood pressure, teeth, gums, tongue, eyes, ears nose and skin. Often early detection can prevent an injury or more serious medical complication.

NOTIFICATION OF HOSPITALIZATION

If you or your loved one is admitted to a Skilled Nursing Facility, your insurance will not pay for any medical equipment for the duration of the stay. This includes diabetic supplies, and nebulizer medications. They do this because the skilled nursing facility should be providing you with these services and supplies during the hospitalization.

It is important that you notify our Billing department of the hospitalization as soon as possible. Depending on the length of hospitalization we may need to pick up the equipment and re-deliver it once you have been discharged. If we are not notified, the insurance will take back the funds paid toward that claim & the responsibility for payment becomes the patients.

BEDS



Sleep is very important when you are sick, and sometimes a regular bed just isn't enough. Hospital beds are a great way to keep your head and feet elevated so you can get that restful sleep you need or want. Our beds are Semi-electric and combine the convenience of head and knee electric positioning with the economy of manual hi-low adjustment.

The hand control raises and lowers the head and knee sections, and a manual crank changes the bed height. The Bed Height is 15" min. - 23" max. (Measurement from floor to bed deck.) with the overall dimensions being 36"W x 88"L, and a weight capacity of 350 lbs. With a prescription from your doctor that qualifies you for a hospital bed most insurances will cover the rental. So stop by or give us a call if you would like to start having a more restful nights sleep.
